



SAR members conducted a dignified program that included a prayer, presentation of the colors, musket salute, and remarks on the significance of honoring those who came before us.

The event was attended by family members, community guests, and several chapter officers.

It marks the Canadian Valley Chapter's first grave marking and reflects the group's commitment to fulfilling one of the core missions of the SAR—honoring the memory of Revolutionary War patriots and their descendants.


Plans are underway for future grave markings in the coming months as the chapter continues to grow its outreach and preservation efforts.








This Month in Revolutionary War History

May 6, 1778 – Alliance Day at Valley Forge

General George Washington assembled the Continental Army at Valley Forge to celebrate the recently formed alliance with France. The event, known as Alliance Day, featured a grand parade and was a significant morale booster for the troops, symbolizing international support for the American cause.

May 10, 1775 – Capture of Fort Ticonderoga

Ethan Allen and Benedict Arnold led a surprise attack on the British-held Fort Ticonderoga in New York. This marked the first offensive victory for American forces in the Revolutionary War, securing a strategic passageway to Canada and providing the patriots with a valuable cache of artillery.

May 15, 1776 – Virginia Calls for Independence

The Virginia Convention passed a resolution instructing its delegates to propose a declaration of independence to the Continental Congress. This action was a pivotal step toward the drafting and adoption of the Declaration of Independence.

May 20, 1778 - Battle of Barren Hill

Under the command of the Marquis de Lafayette, Continental forces narrowly escaped encirclement by British troops near Philadelphia. The successful retreat at the Battle of Barren Hill demonstrated Lafayette's leadership and the growing competence of the Continental Army.
